**RESOLUTION OF THE 46 GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING – IAB**

VENEZUELA

WHEREAS:

The prevailing situation in Venezuela, where there is no Freedom of Expression or guarantees for the validity of Human Rights.

CONSIDERING:

That the Venezuelan Government maintains and even increases its procedures of persecution of journalists, as well as the systematic censorship on the ever shrinking number of independent media.

That at the same time, the regime of President Maduro has prohibited the distribution and broadcast of signals from international channels, as well as the work of correspondents is restricted and the entry of foreign journalists is prohibited.

That radio stations continue to be silenced by arbitrary technical arguments or the non-renewal of their operating licenses.

MEETING IN BUENOS AIRES, ARGENTINA, RESOLVES:**

On the tenth anniversary of the arbitrary closure of Radio Caracas Televisión, we reiterate our strongest condemnation of the regime that governs Venezuela, with absolute disregard for Human Rights, Freedom of Expression and Democracy.
