**RESOLUTION OF IAB BOARD OF DIRECTORS
ARGENTINA**

WHEREAS:

The provisions of AFSCA Resolutions No. 1047/14 and 1329/14 and Decree No. 2456/14, which establish new categories of licensees.

CONSIDERING:

That these standards provide technical limitations for the providers of over-the-air television, making it impossible to access new technologies such as 4K. These providers require, for their digital broadcasts of the highest quality, the total authorized bandwidth 6 MHz / 18 Mbps.

That regulations such as these limit the quality of service and prevent the incorporation of new technologies that are already available in other countries.

That these kind of standards have no background in the countries that are currently using and have developed the ISDB-T standard (Japan and Brazil), and affect the rights of service providers.

**THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING,
MEETING IN SAN JOSÉ, REPUBLIC OF COSTA RICA, RESOLVES:**

To reiterate what was resolved by IAB General Assembly in its Resolution Doc.31 / 2015, requesting the Executive of the Argentine Nation to repeal or modify the aforementioned standards and encourage it to preserve the bandwidth allocated to ensure the population the free reception of maximum quality broadcasts, facilitating the healthy competitiveness and the sustainability of radio and television.
