



IAB CONDEMNS THE MURDER OF A JOURNALIST IN HONDURAS

The International Association of Broadcasting - IAB - expresses its strongest condemnation and rejection for the murder of journalist and communicator Igor Padilla, which took place on January 17 in the city of San Pedro de Sula.

Padilla, who was working on the information section of HCH television channel, was monitoring the recording of an advertisement when he received a phone call that made him go out into the street. There, he was attacked by four hooded individuals who shot him several times, causing his death.

According to official information, the police would have already caught several of the subjects involved in the attack and they have been brought to justice.

IAB expresses its deepest condolences to the family of the victim and to the staff of HCH in view of this sorrowful event, as well as its sympathy with journalists, communicators and media of Honduras, in the light of the escalation of violence that affects the country.
