**RESOLUTION OF IAB 43rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY
BRAZIL**

WHEREAS:

The repeated incursions by explorer companies of different broadcasting activities on the Brazilian market, with the aim of developing journalistic activities, particularly through the World Wide Web, without respecting the specific regulatory framework.

CONSIDERING:

- 1) That the Brazilian Constitution ensures that the ownership of the press, sound and images broadcasting companies has been exclusive for native and naturalized Brazilians for over 10 years;
- 2) That the management of the activities and the establishment of program content should necessarily be exercised by Brazilians;
- 3) That the editorial responsibility and selection and direction activities of the broadcast programming are exclusive for native or naturalized Brazilians that have been in any mass media for over ten years;

THE 43rd GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING - IAB, MEETING IN RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL, RESOLVES:

To express its concern about the fact that companies are exploring and producing news and entertainment content, disrespecting the relevant regulatory framework and causing serious violation of Brazilian sovereignty.

To prompt the government on the adoption of the necessary measures for compliance with the law in force.
