

## RESOLUTION OF IAB 43<sup>RD</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY

### COORDINATION BETWEEN COUNTRIES FOR BROADCAST SPECTRUM MANAGEMENT

#### CONSIDERING:

- 1) That the use of radioelectric spectrum by stations operating next to the border in most American countries , especially illegal ones, produces harmful interference situations and lack of control.
- 2) That the recommendations of the International Telecommunication Union - ITU - and treaties between countries, such as MERCOSUR, indicate the need to manage the electromagnetic spectrum in a coordinated manner.
- 3) That the advent of new digital modulation techniques for broadcasting requires and will require the operation on new frequencies.

#### THE 43<sup>RD</sup> GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING - IAB - MEETING IN RIO DE JANEIRO, BRAZIL, RESOLVES:

To urge the administrations of the countries to comply with international coordination standards regulated by the ITU coordination and by regional multinational agreements which countries should follow.
