**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE  
INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING – IAB**

**COORDINATION BETWEEN COUNTRIES FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE SPECTRUM**

**CONSIDERING:**

- 1) That the use of the radioelectric spectrum by stations operating in borders in most American countries, especially illegal ones, produce harmful interference and lack of control.
- 2) That the recommendations of the International Telecommunication Union - ITU - and treaties between countries, such as MERCOSUR, indicate a need to administrate the electromagnetic spectrum in a coordinated manner.
- 3) That the introduction of new digital modulation techniques for broadcasting requires and will require operating at new frequencies.

**THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF BROADCASTING  
MEETING IN SANTIAGO DE CALI, COLOMBIA, MAY 30, 2014, RESOLVES:**

To urge the countries' administrations to respect international coordination provisions regulated by ITU and by regional (multinational) agreements to which countries have to comply.
